CROCK-POT CHOCOLATE CANDY

2 lb. (36 oz. dry roasted peanuts

4 oz. (4 squares) German's sweet chocolate

1 12-oz. package semisweet chocolate chips (about 2 cups)

2 $\frac{1}{2}$ lbs. white almond bark

Put the peanuts in the bottom of a 4 quart slow-cooker. Layer the chocolate over the peanuts, beginning with the semi-sweet chocolate followed by the chocolate chips and then the almond bark. Set the temperature on low and cook for 3 hours. Do not stir the mixture. After 3 hours, stir the mixture with a wooden spoon until smooth. Drop the candy into cupcake pan liners, using 2 tablespoons per liner. Allow the candy to cool completely before removing the cupcake liner.
