## **EASY KNITTED FACE MASK**

Materials:

Cotton yarn,

Size 5 knitting needles

Cast on 38 stitches

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Sl 4 stitches, Knit 30 stitches, Purl 4

stitches

Row 3: Sl 4 stitches, Knit all stitches to end of row.

Repeat rows 2 & 3 for a total of 44 rows.

Bind off

Crochet a chain of 70 stitches.

Thread the chain through the loops made on the knitted face piece (mask)

Adjust to individual size.

## \*\* Important:

Row 2: after you slip the first 4 stitches, bring the yarn behind your work, then knit the next 30 stitches, Purl last 4 stitches.

Row 3: after you slip the first 4 stitched, bring the yarn to the front of your work, then knit the next 34 stitches to the end.

This will form loops on the back of the mask so you can thread the crochet chain through.

Tie the adjustable crochet loops go behind your ears to secure the mask.
