APPLE CRISP made with apple brandy

INGREDIENTS

2 lbs. peeled, cored sliced apples
(about 9 cups)

¼ c rum, apple cider, or juice, or the liquor/juice of your choice; or water.

¼ c to ¾ c brown sugar, depending on the sweetness/tartness of the apples

2 T melted butter

2 T boiled cider, optional but good

1 ½ t Apple pie spice of 1 t cinnamon + ¼ t nutmeg
+ ¼ t ginger

3 T all-purpose flour or tapioca flour

¼ t salt

TOPPING

¾ c all-purpose flour

½ c quick-cooking oats

heaping ¼ t salt

2/3 c brown sugar packed

1 t cinnamon

¾ t baking powder

8 T butter, cold, cut in pats

½ c diced pecans or walnuts

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350. Grease a 9" X 9" pan or similar-size casserole pan.

Slice the apples about ¼" thick. Toss them with the remaining filling ingredients and spread them in the pan.

To make the topping, whisk together the flour, oats, salt, sugar, cinnamon and baking powder.

Add the cold butter, working it in to make an unevenly crumbly mixture. Stir in the nuts, if you're using them.
