### RHUBARB SALAD

4 c. diced fresh or frozen rhubarb

 $1 \frac{1}{2}$  c. water

½ c. sugar

1 (6-oz.) pkg. strawberry gelatin

1 c. orange juice

1 tsp. grated orange peel

1 c. sliced fresh strawberries

In a medium saucepan over med. heat, bring the rhubarb, water and sugar to a boil. Cook uncovered until rhubarb is tender, about 6-8 minutes. Remove from the heat; stir in gelatin until dissolved. Add orange juice and peel; mix well. Chill, until mixture begins to thicken. Fold in strawberries. Pour into a 2qt.bowl; chill until set. If desired, garnish with a dallop of mayonnaise, mint and strawberries. Yield 12-14 servings. (I also used this on top of ice cream).
